



Ecuador Webinar: Political and Economic Outlook after snap elections



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Much has happened in Ecuador in recent days. The murder of one of the main presidential candidates has convoluted domestic politics. Bondholders have interpreted that the events could lower the chances of the candidate representing former president Rafael Correa's party. Nothing should be taken for granted, though. No new polls are available, but until the shooting of Mr. Villavicencio the level of political apathy had reached unprecedented highs on the back of a severe security crisis that is undermining public confidence in authorities. We will analyse the electoral implications of the 20 August snap election and the outlook for Ecuadoran bonds.
